Phase 2	Successful completion of Three (3) program core requirements (FMGT- 211 & 212; HMGT-220), One Gen Ed. Prerequisite –EC-132/131, one major elective- (TMGT-130) with a grade of “C” or better. Involvement in one professional industry association (Student Chapter).
Phase 3	Successful completion of HMGT – 340; FMGT-350; and HMGT – 305, plus six (6) program core requirements with grade of “C” or better.
Phase 4	Successful completion of Work experience requirements, Capstone Course (HMGT-404), and all additional program major courses and free electives

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
