Military Affiliated Students Should Complete the Following Steps:

- 1. Contact your Education Service Officer (ESO) or Counselor prior to enrolling.
- 2. Apply for VA benefits https://www.va.gov/education/how-to-apply/.
- 3. Pick your program from the list of Undergraduate and Graduate below. Please click on the program to see the program requirements including degree completion plan.
- 4. Complete your application to the University of Maryland Eastern Shore using the fee waiver code **VETERAN** https://wwwcp.umes.edu/admissions/apply-for-admission/
 - a. First you have to create a portal at <u>futurehawk.umes.edu</u>
 - b. Then, you can apply and submit your admission application
- 5. Submit the following documentation to the Office of Admissions by uploading them to your https://futurehawk.umes.edu/ portal or email them to umesadmissions@umes.edu
 - a. Highschool/College Transcripts

- 6. Upon acceptance, please submit Certificate of Eligibility and DD214 to umesadmissions@umes.edu. You will receive information about registration next Steps by checking your email and your student portal.
- 7. View your College Financing Plan listed on your **MYUMES** Hawkweb account.

 - 2. Click on Hawk Web Student Center

- 3. Click on Finances
- 4. Click on View Financial Aid
- 5. Click on the appropriate aid year

Section two: Once Enrolled Student should complete these steps every semester

- 1. Veteran education benefits will be submitted upon receipt of Veterans Education Enrollment Request Google Form <u>VEER FORM</u>. Please complete a Veterans Education Request Form every semester you wish to use veteran benefits.
- 2. A Veterans Education Request form is also required whenever a change is made to the course schedule (i.e, major change, withdrawal, add, drop).
- 3. Students are responsible for all fees not covered by veteran benefits.

SECTION THREE: If you have a complaint in regards to your veteran benefits:

- 1. Contact your SCO at <u>umesadmissions@umes.edu</u> with your specific complaint to see if the issue can be resolved.
- 2. If your issue cannot be resolved, you may submit a complaint through the VA GI Bill Feedback Tool if UMES is failing to follow the Principles of Excellence. VA will review the following types of complaints:
