

Breakdown of Fees by Academic Year Aviation Science, Professional Pilot Program Fall 2023

In addition to regular tuition and student fees, students enrolled in the Bachelor of Science, Aviation Science degree program with a Concentration in Professional Pilot are responsible for flight training and ground school course fees. As of the fall semester of 2023, the amount of these fees, by academic year, is detailed below:

Individual student progress may vary and transfer of flight credentials or other academics may dictate that some flight courses are taken simultaneously. Additionally, flight course failures may require repeats of flight courses. Therefore, the exact timing and total amount of fees may vary for an individual.
