

How to get the Best Help from Brainfuse



Come Prepared

- Know what you want to work on: a concept, writing prompt, math problem, or specific assignment.
- Upload your assignment, paste the question in the chat, or write it out on the whiteboard.
- The more info, the better.



Share What You Know

- Mention what your teacher expects and what you've already tried.
- Let the tutor know what you've already tried and where you're stuck.



Ask and Answer Questions

- Ask questions, share thoughts, and let the tutor know if something isn't clear.
- The more you participate, the more helpful the session will be.



Work Through It Together

- Tutors won't do the work *for* you, they'll guide you *through* it.
- Expect to be asked questions, solve parts of the problem, or revise your writing live.



Take It from Here

- By the end of the session, you should feel clearer about the concept and ready to keep going on your own.
- Try a similar problem or review your notes to reinforce what you've learned.



Remember

Tutors don't have your course info unless you share it.

Tutors are here to teach, not just give answers.

Asking questions = learning more.
