DIRECTIONS TO THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND EASTERN SHORE

- ✓ **FROM NEW YORK & POINTS NORTH (APPROX. 240 MILES)**

Take I-95 South to the New Jersey Turnpike. Cross the Delaware Memorial Bridge and follow signs to US-13 South (Dover, DE / Norfolk, VA). Continue through Salisbury, MD to Princess Anne, MD and follow signs to MD Route 822 (UMES Boulevard). The Student Services Center will be on your right.
- ✓ **FROM THE PHILADELPHIA AREA (APPROX. 150 MILES)**

Take I-95 South to I-495 South (Exit 11 toward Port of Wilmington/Baltimore). Merge onto DE-1 South, then take US-13 South (Exit 97) toward Salisbury/Norfolk. Continue through Salisbury to Princess Anne and follow signs to MD Route 822 (UMES Boulevard). Follow UMES Boulevard to the end, bear right, then make a sharp left. The Student Services Center will be on your right.
- ✓ **FROM BALTIMORE, WASHINGTON DC & ALEXANDRIA, VA (APPROX. 140 MILES)**

Travel to the Chesapeake Bay Bridge to the Eastern Shore. Take US-50 East to Salisbury, MD, then US-13 South to Princess Anne. Follow signs to MD Route 822 (UMES Boulevard). Follow UMES Boulevard to the end, bear right, then make a sharp left. The Student Services Center will be on your right.
- ✓ **FROM NORTH & SOUTH CAROLINA & POINTS SOUTH**

Take I-85 to Route 58 to Route 17 (Norfolk, VA), then US-13 North across the Chesapeake Bay Bridge–Tunnel into Maryland. Pass through Pocomoke City to Princess Anne. Follow signs to Somerset Ave. (MD-675), turn right onto Broad Street (second traffic light), continue to campus, cross the railroad tracks, turn left onto Backbone Road, and proceed to the third driveway entrance on the right to the Student Services Center.

PARKING & SHUTTLE INSTRUCTIONS FOR RECRUITERS



You can unload your **materials and afterwards, you must go back out Student Services Center Lane and turn left.** Then **make the first right** into the **gated parking lot (S)**. In order to avoid receiving a parking ticket, this parking lot has been reserved for recruiters and students only. The shuttle bus will then start operating from **8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon** for recruiters participating in the Annual Spring Career & Internship Expo. The bus will begin operating again at **2:00 p.m.** to take recruiters back to parking lot (S). There will also be **Career Service Ambassadors** available if you have any questions.

Shuttle Service Schedule

Shuttle vans will transport recruiters between Parking Lot S and the Student Services Center during the following times:

- 8:00 a.m.–12:00 p.m.
- 1:00 p.m.–4:30 p.m.
