Eligibility

YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY IF YOU MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING

- Undergraduate attending an institution with an active Phi Kappa Phi chapter
- Cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher
- Study abroad program begins between May 1, 2025, and June 30, 2026
- Applied to or accepted into an accredited study abroad program before the session deadline
- Can provide a letter of acceptance or a letter confirming your application, on official letterhead, as part of your application
- Transcripts are required for each academic institution granting credit hours

A copy of your transcript(s), unofficial acceptable if GPA is clearly stated

Two letters of recommendation an acceptance letter into an accredited study abroad program

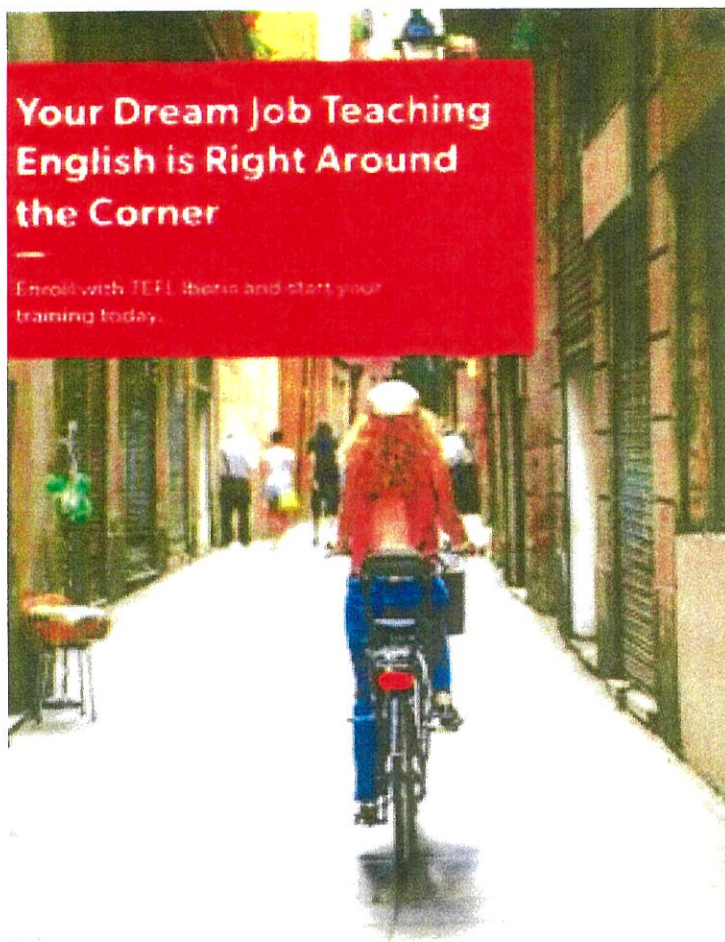
