WORKSHOP FOR TEACHERS (CMARS)

Teachers from **Wicomico, Somerset and Worcester counties or local teachers** are invited to participate in a **paid, two-week on-campus workshop** to gain tools to create lesson plans, educational and/or lab activities in environmental science. Participating teachers will have the opportunity to learn from and work with faculty in the NSF CREST-CISCEP and NOAA LMRCSC programs at UMES. Participants will participate in follow-up sessions throughout the year to evaluate the lesson plans produced in the workshop and assess the effectiveness of the program. The workshop is guided by the Center's Education and Outreach Coordinator Dr. Patricia Goslee, and is funded by the National Science Foundation.

INCENTIVES

Teachers will receive a stipend of \$1100.00 and lunch during the summer workshop experience. Program staff can sign-off on continuing education or professional development credits if needed.

WHEN

The workshop will run from 9:00am – 3:00pm, July 11- 22, 2022, and follow-up sessions will occur during the following academic year.
