## Student Eligibility Checklist & Requirements

The following checklist is provided to ensure all requirements are understood and all aspects of the application process are completed. *Applicants who do not meet all requirements are removed from consideration. Award recipients who fail to maintain all requirements void their award.*

- Applicant must be enrolled at an institution of higher education with an accredited teacher education program.
- Applicant must be admitted to a teacher education program.
- Applicant must have a grade point average at 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
- Applicant must be a junior or senior undergraduate or a graduate student.
- Applicant must be a racial minority.
- Applicant must submit two references using the attached form.
  - One must be from a faculty member or other college/university official.
  - One must be from a non-university related person familiar with the applicant's skills and abilities who is not a family member.
- Application must be postmarked or time stamped by April 1, 2011:
