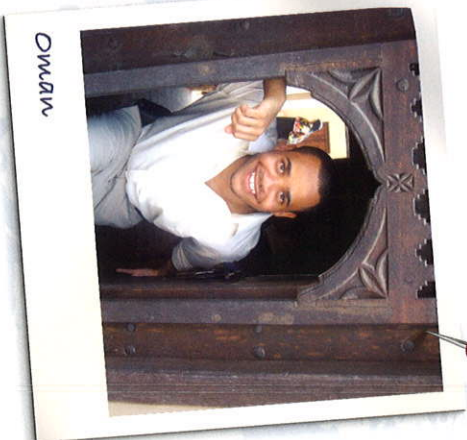
The Gilman International Scholarship Program offers scholarships for U.S. citizen undergraduate students of limited financial means to pursue academic studies abroad.

**OUR MISSION**

Named after retired Congressman Benjamin A. Gilman from New York, the program's goal is to diversify the kinds of students who study abroad and the countries and regions where they go. Specifically, the Gilman Scholarship Program offers scholarships for students who have been traditionally underrepresented in education abroad.

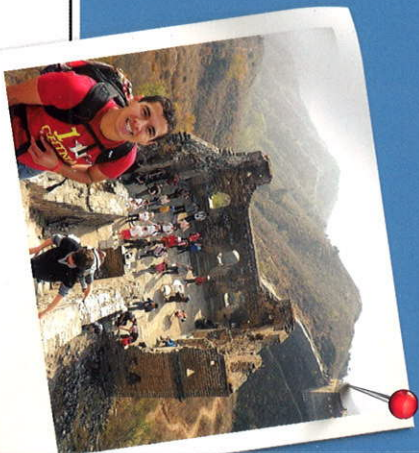
**AWARDS**

Award recipients receive up to \$5,000 to apply toward study abroad program costs, including program fees, tuition, room and board, airfare, books and local transportation.

**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen undergraduate student at a 2 or 4 year institution in the United States.
- Applicant must be receiving a Federal Pell Grant at the time of application or during the term of study abroad.
- Applicant must be applying to a study abroad program eligible for credit at the student's institution of higher education in the U.S.
- Applicant must be studying abroad for a minimum of 4 weeks in one country.

- Study abroad program can take place in any country that is not on the U.S. Department of State's Travel Warning list or Cuba.



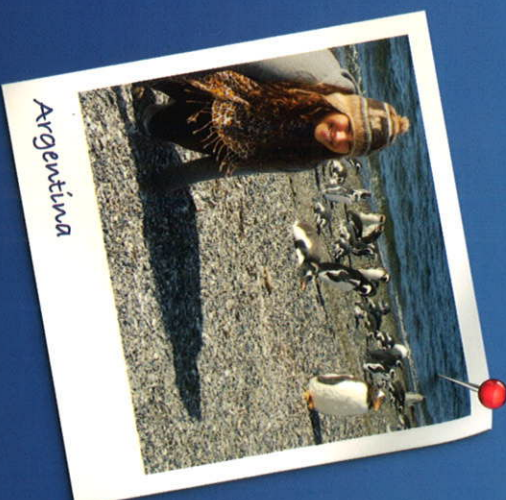

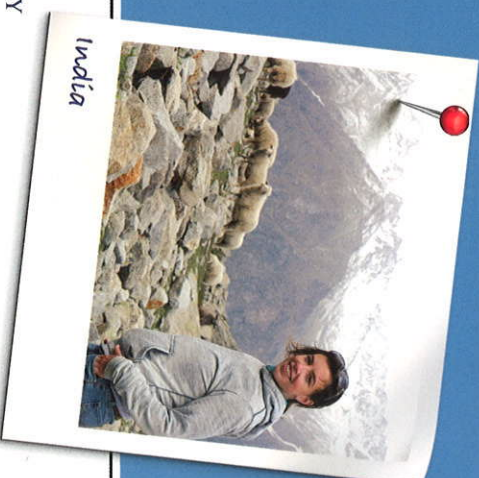
