If you discover heat, excessive smoke, or fire while inside a building:

Activate fire alarm system in building, call 911, and notify UMES Police at EXT 3300.

Report smoke or fire outside a building to campus police at EXT 3300.

FIRE EVACUATION PROCEDURES

Occupants should go to the nearest exit when the alarm sounds. If access to the nearest exit is obstructed, an alternate exit should be used.

Report to the evacuation assembly point as directed by evacuation wardens:

Inside Assembly Point (s): In front of receptionist area in the lobby on the main floor. **Outside Assembly Point(s):** In front of the building (South-West side); next to the farm building (South-west corner); behind the building (North-East side); between the radio station and the green house.

Remain at least 50 ft from the building and out of the way of responding emergency personnel.

DO NOT re-enter the building until directed to do so by emergency officials.
