The application closure for the [Department of Navy – Naval Research Laboratory HBCU/MI Internship Program](#) is quickly approaching.

Program details are listed below. To be included, students should be sure to [submit an application!](#)

- Internship duration: June 1st, 2021 – August 6th, 2021
- **This year's summer internship is remote ("work-from-home")**
 - \$8,500 for undergraduate students
 - \$10,900 for graduate students)
 - Stipend is paid out during the internship – on the 15th & last of the month
- The project you would work on will be determined based on your submitted interests. [View past internship projects on the Department of Navy website](#). Each student is paired with a mentor who is a staffer at the NRL - Opportunities are provided to virtually network with current and past NRL interns. (2020 cohort: 36 interns)
- Required Application Materials
 - Resume
 - Transcript
 - Contact information for two (2) references
 - Writing Sample
 - What has motivated you to be in the science/STEM field?
 - What are your current career goals?
 - Why do you enjoy certain aspects of science?
 - How could the internship help you in reaching your future goals?

Feel free also to check in with me via email – I am not a part of the selection process and can provide some direction or keep track of application progress. **We encourage students to submit their material by the end of the day Friday, February 19th** for expedited processing.
