Program details are listed below. To be included, students should be sure to submit an application!


- Internship duration: June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- This year's summer internship is remote ("work-from-home")
  - \$8,500 for undergraduate students
  - \$10,900 for graduate students)
  - o Stipend is paid out during the internship on the 15<sup>th</sup> & last of the month
- The project you would work on will be determined based on your submitted interests. <u>View past internship projects on the Department of Navy website</u>. Each student is paired with a mentor who is a staffer at the NRL Opportunities are provided to virtually network with current and past NRL interns. (2020 cohort: 36 interns)
- Required Application Materials
  - o Resume
  - Transcript
  - Contact information for two (2) references
  - Writing Sample
    - What has motivated you to be in the science/STEM field?
    - What are your current career goals?
    - Why do you enjoy certain aspects of science?
    - How could the internship help you in reaching your future goals?

Feel free also to check in with me via email – I am not a part of the selection process and can provide some direction or keep track of application progress. We encourage students to submit their material by the end of the day Friday, February 19<sup>th</sup> for expedited processing.
