Summary

- **Tuition & Fees:** Tuition and fees are set by the Office of Finance and approved by the Board of Regents. Tuition and fees are based on current 2022-2023 flat rates.
- **Living Expenses:**
 - The housing/ food allowance for students who live on-campus includes \$3,598.50/ semester [\$7,197 total] for housing based upon the median on-campus housing charge and \$2,600.50/ semester [\$5,201 total] for food, based upon 21 meals per week.
 - The housing/ food allowance for students who live off-campus, not with parents includes \$3,598.50/ semester [\$7,197 total] for housing and other living expenses based in MD Fair Market Rate for 1 bedroom and \$2,600.50/ semester [\$5,201 total] for food based upon 21 meals per week.
 - The housing/ food allowance for students who live off-campus with parents includes \$1,799.25/ semester [\$3,598.50 total] for housing and \$2,600.50/ semester [\$5,201 total] for food based upon 21 meals per week.
- **Federal Student Loan Fees:** An allowance for the cost of any Federal Student Loan Fee, Origination Fee, or Insurance Premium charged to the student or the parent of the student. UMES uses the average Loan Fee for Subsidized and Unsubsidized Loans, and the actual Loan Fee for PLUS Loan borrowers. The budget is adjusted with the actual Loan Fee for PLUS [GRAD and Parent] with each approved loan.
- **Books, Course Material, Supplies & Equipment:** Based upon College Board 22-23 Average Estimated Figures for Four Year Public Institutions, listed below.
