- IV. Provide two (2) letters of recommendation: RECOMMENDER LINKS ARE ON THE WEBSITE
 - a. One from a school counselor or professor Must use the ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT LINK
 - b. One from the organization for your community service on letterhead Must use the COMMUNITY SERVICE LINK
- V. Have a minimum unweighted **GPA of 3.25 or higher**
