



HOMECOMING EVENT POLICY

The below policy applies to all Homecoming events and activities unless otherwise specified. There is a separate policy for the Homecoming Tailgate Event. For Alumni Events, please check with the National Alumni Association and/or the Office of Alumni Relations for related policies.

NO (STRICTLY PROHIBITED)

- No Weapons, Including Pocket Knives
- No Cigarettes, Cigars, E-Cigarettes, Or Vapes
- No Open Containers, Alcohol, Plastic Bottles, Glass Bottles, Or Cups (Including Tumblers)
- No Drugs Or Drug Paraphernalia (Including Lighters)
- No Outside Food Or Beverage
- No Purses, Pocketbooks, Backpacks, Or Large Bags
- No Wallet/Pants Or Trouser Chains
- No Mace Or Pepper Spray
- No Ski Masks Or Face Covering
- No Ins And Outs During Events Or Activities
- No Sharing Of Hawkcards Or Student Information (Violators Will Be Admitted)
- No Cracked, Taped, Or Faded Hawkcard Will Be Accepted At The Door!
- No Admittance For Those Under The Influence Of Drugs Or Alcohol
- No Tickets May Be Purchased At The Door. For Ticketed Events, Please Visit The Website For More Information Before The Start Of The Event. Note: There Are Capacities For Each Event And Activity.
- No Fighting Or Physical Altercation. (This May Result In The Immediate Discontinuance Of The Event Or Activity. Violators Will Be BANNED From Remaining Homecoming Events, And May Be Suspended or Expelled from UMES).

CRITICAL REMINDERS FOR HOMECOMING EVENTS

- For Students - You Must Always Have Your UMES Student ID. No Hawkcard, No Entry! No Exceptions!
- For Alumni And Guests – You Must Always Have A State-Issued ID Or License.
- Small Clutches and Clear Bags (No Bigger Than 4”X8”) ONLY Are Permitted.
- Confiscated Items Will NOT Be Returned.
- No Refunds Will Be Issued For Purchased Tickets.
- Each Event And Activity Has A “Doors Closed” Period. During This Time, No Student Or Guest Will Be Admitted To The Event Or Activity.
- UMES And Law Enforcement Staff Are Present For Safety Reasons. Students And Guests Must Adhere To The Instructions And Directives Provided To These Officials.
- The Code Of Student Conduct Applies To All Students – On And Off Campus, Before, During, And After Events/Activities.
- Check The UMES Website For Event And Activities Changes.
