UMES Policy on Human Subjects Research Compliance Training

Human subjects research compliance training is required for all principal investigators, as well as their personnel, who conduct research on human subjects. Training is provided through CITI (https://about.citiprogram.org/). Training certificates are required at the time of submission of an application to the IRB. Failure of the PI to submit the appropriate certification(s) for all personnel will result in rejection of the IRB application.

Requisite training for principal investigators and personnel includes the following CITI courses:

- 1) Responsible Conduct of Research for Human Subjects; and
- 2) Biomedical Research OR Social and Behavioral Research OR Students conducting no more than minimal risk research Students Class projects
- 3) Certifications as deemed necessary by the IRB to protect subjects.
