APPLICATION PROCESS

 - Write a personal statement.
 - Submit 3 recommendation letters.
 - Submit a copy of your transcript.
- 3 The Admissions Committee reviews your verified PharmCAS application.
- 4 Attend your admissions interview (invite only)
