

News from Physical Therapy Instruction Captured & Uploaded for Students

TEGRITY, a classroom capture recording software, is being used in the foundational science courses in the DPT curriculum, specifically Advanced Human Anatomy, Advanced Physiology, Pathophysiology, and Neuroscience. The software records the lecture simultaneously with the PowerPoint slides and other materials that are projected from the instructor's laptop. The lectures are uploaded to Blackboard and the students are able to replay the class lectures on their personal computers, iPods, or MP3 players anytime and as many times as they would like.
